## How to book:

- Students moving into Halls will be invited to enrol and move into halls by our Accommodation team. We will email you with information on how to book your enrolment and arrival slot through the accommodation portal. Accommodation slots are on 24 and 25 September. See list of specific Halls' dates.
- Non-Halls Students will be invited to enrol via email. You must book an enrolment slot via our Enrolment Booking Form.

## Confirming your identity

At the enrolment session we will need to confirm your identify therefore you will need to bring the following:

- UK Nationals Passport or Driving Licence (including provisional)
- Overseas Nationals Passport (and BRP card if applicable)

Please ensure you also bring other identification documents (e.g. bank card, birth certificate, official letter) in case we need to identify you further. If you are a UK national and do not have a passport of driving licence then you should bring official documents which will allow us to identify you.

If, when you are completing your Pre enrolment, your Student Status is 'Not Known' please scan and email the following relevant information to <u>feestatus@northampton.ac.uk</u> and bring your documents to your Face to Face enrolment session.

- Passport
- Biometric Residence Card or if UK resident EU national an Immigration Share Code

## In addition:

- Students who are Home fee payers on the basis of long residency in the UK should provide evidence of SFE funding
- Applicants with time limited leave to remain who are the spouse or child of a UK national should be able to provide evidence of the relationship and evidence of the nationality of the parent/spouse
