### Car Parking

Directions to Avenue Campus and a campus map can be found on our website at the following [link](#).

Please note that the student car park is free to visitors during the day. However, it can be quite busy, so please allow enough time to find a space.

In order to gain access to the student car park you will need the barrier code: \*2591#

The barrier code should be entered on the keypad on either of the two access barriers at the entrance to the student car park at Avenue Campus.

- The \* 'star' and # 'hash' must be included as part of the barrier code.
- An intercom to the Security Lodge is located on each barrier if difficulties arise.

### By Train

Northampton railway station is located approximately half a mile to the west of Northampton Town Centre. You can catch the No. 19 Uno Bus from here which goes to both Avenue Campus and Park Campus. You can view the bus timetable on this [link](#).

### By Taxi

If you are catching a taxi to the University, please make sure you tell the driver which campus you need to go to.

## Arrival and structure of the day.

The time you have been invited to attend your interview is your registration time. This allows for your documents to be checked prior to attending your interview.

On arrival please register in Maidwell Reception at Avenue Campus.

Please prepare to spend a full day on campus.

## Preparation for interview.

Please read carefully the following information and instructions, which are intended to help you with your interview.

You are requested to bring the following:

- Evidence of examinations achieved, so far – which can be brought in on hard copies or sent via email
- Any useful information about the content of your present course i.e. any moving image pieces or photographs that you might have.

## Interview process.

We know that an interview can be a daunting experience. We make allowances for nerves and we endeavor to make the process as enjoyable as possible.

The interview will give you an opportunity to explore the potentials of the course. It will also give us the chance to know you better and provide you with early guidance in how to successfully start the course.

The interview will be relatively informal and will include an overview of BA (Hons) Media Production and Moving Image programme, a group activity as well as an interview with the members of our academic staff team.

The group activity will allow you to meet other applicants for your chosen course and will include an introduction to the TV studio and making a TV segment.

During your interview you will be asked to talk us through your current course with examples, discuss your future aspirations and answer any questions that we might have. The interview process usually lasts approximately **20-30 minutes**.

## **Facilities and services tour.**

Starting from the registration point in Maidwell Reception, current student ambassadors will provide a comprehensive tour of the University facilities. Our tour times are 11am, 12noon and 1pm and may take up to 45 minutes to do. Parents and guests are welcome to join tours.

## **Waterside Campus tour (optional).**

A free bus will take you to the site of our new Waterside Campus. The campus is still under construction, but there is a public footpath which you can stroll along and take a look at developments. Staff will be on hand to answer your questions. Parents and guests are welcome to join this tour, however, applicants will take priority.
