
While you are here take a visit to the town and our new Waterside Campus, to find out more about life in Northampton.

Northampton life.

Northampton has the perfect combination of bustling urban life and peaceful countryside; from exciting entertainment at the Royal & Derngate Theatre to a lively nightlife at pubs and clubs. Visit Abington Street and St Giles Street to see our high street and independent shops. Delicious food and drink venues are spread across the town in an array of restaurants, pubs and cafés. Take a stroll through one of our scenic parks, like the Racecourse, or visit one of our famous sporting venues, like Silverstone, for an exciting day out. All within easy reach for our students, Northampton is a great place to study and live.



Town centre walking tour.

Our town centre tour will introduce you to the town's main attractions and areas, giving you an authentic feel for the culture, leisure activities, shopping and historic sites Northampton has to offer. The place to park for our tours is the St John's car park **NN1 1HA**, which is free for two hours on a weekday and £2 to park all day on Saturdays and Sundays.

A Starting outside our town centre student accommodation, St John's Hall of Residence, head up the hill on Guildhall Road.

You are passing through Northampton's Cultural Quarter, where you can find the Northampton Museum, currently undergoing refurbishment; The Royal & Derngate Theatre, where our Graduation Ceremonies take place; 78 Derngate, a Rennie Mackintosh designed house; NN Art Gallery and the Errol Flynn Filmhouse, where you can enjoy classic and modern films.


B At the top of the road you will see one of Northampton's grandest buildings, the Guildhall. This has been the hub of Northampton since 1864.

C From here turn left along St Giles Square until you see Prezzo and Nando's up Wood Hill. Head up Wood Hill passing Abington Street on your right. There are two indoor shopping centres off Abington Street, The Grosvenor Centre and Market Walk. Both offer high street shopping to meet everyone's taste and have many boutique shops unique to Northampton.

D You should now be standing in Northampton's Town Square where our open air market is held.

E On the corner of Silver Street is the Bus Station offering transport to and from our campus and the railway station, with easy access into London, Birmingham and Milton Keynes.

Students who have a valid student card can travel between Waterside, Boughton Green Road and St George's Avenue on weekdays for free and into town for just £1. Normal rates apply at the weekend.



F Turn left into The Drapery and head down the hill. Here you will see some of the town's unique shops, banking facilities and department stores.

At the end of this road you will see Bridge Street and Gold Street in front of you.

G Follow George Row, where you will pass The Platform, our new Students' Union venue (this is also the home of Unitemps, our recruitment agency, if you plan to look for work while you study), as well as All Saints Church and café on your left.

The tourist information on your right provides details of all events taking place within the town.

Follow the road straight ahead where you will go back past The Old Bank. When you get to ASK restaurant, go down the hill where you will get back to St John's Hall of Residence at the bottom.
