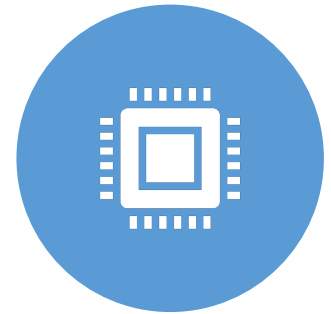

Continue	Stop	Start
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ All forms of assessment that do not require real-time attendance.▪ Prepare for and engage with all assessment activity as normal. 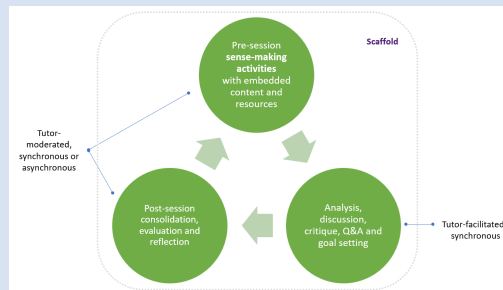
