This intensive course provides a comprehensive understanding of leather science and technology by combining theoretic and practical modes of delivery - an ideal opportunity to further your existing leather knowledge!

The course is split into five units, each studied intensively for one or two week periods (Monday - Thursday), with Leather Science running every Friday throughout the three-month period.

As a measure of engagement you will be encouraged to produce a final portfolio reflecting the learning journey of your time at the Institute for Creative Leather Technologies (ICLT)

The modules include:

- Research and Analytical Methods: 8 Jan - 11 Jan
- Leather Process Operations: 15 Jan - 25 Jan
- Sustainable Manufacture within the Leather Industry: 5 Feb - 15 Feb
- Performance Leather Process Operations: 26 Feb - 8 Mar
- Quality Evaluation and Systematic Problem Solving: 12 Mar - 22 Mar
- Leather Science: Every Friday throughout the three-month period
