ENTRY REQUIREMENTS, TUITION FEES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Entry requirements

To join a BA or BSc Top-Up programme, you must hold an HND or have completed the equivalent of two years' UK undergraduate study in a relevant subject area. In addition, you must hold IELTS 6.0 (or equivalent) with a minimum of 5.5 in all bands*. We offer Pre-Sessional English Programmes if you have not yet reached this level of English.

To join our MSc Accounting and Finance Top-Up you will have successfully completed professional qualifications such as AIA, ACA, ACCA, CIMA, ICAP, or CPA Australia, or an international equivalent such as OTHM Level 7 Diploma in Accounting and Finance (RQF). In addition, you must hold IELTS 6.5 (or equivalent) with a minimum of 5.5 in all bands. We offer Pre-Sessional English Programmes if you have not yet reached this level of English.

Tuition fees

The tuition fee for the academic year 2021-22 was £13,900. Fees are subject to an annual increase.

Scholarships

Our International Scholarship scheme offers a tuition fee reduction of 10%, 20% or 30%. This is awarded automatically based on your academic achievement, so you do not need to apply separately. (Terms and Conditions apply).

HOW TO APPLY.

Once you've decided that you would like to study with us, our aim is to make the application process as straightforward as possible. So we can consider your application, you'll need to include the following documentation:

Your education history

Tell us where you studied, what qualifications you already have and include copies of your certificates or transcripts. If you have studies you've not yet completed, include your predicted result, then send us your final results as soon as you have them.

Proof of English language competence

Please check the course-specific requirements on our website.

A Personal Statement

Explain why you would like to study your chosen course and what you plan to do with your qualification.

A reference or letter of recommendation

If you're still studying or have recently completed your studies, this should be from one of your teachers, explaining your academic potential and suitability for the course. If you're in work, this should be from your employer.
