# The Reverend Richard Coles The Chancellor.



Reverend Richard Coles was born in Northampton and educated at Wellingborough School and later King's College London, where he studied Theology. He holds an MA by research from the University of Leeds.

Ordained in 2005, Reverend Coles was, until last year, the Vicar of St Mary the Virgin in Finedon, Northamptonshire. Until earlier this year, he co-presented BBC Radio 4's *Saturday Live* show and continues to be a regular guest on flagship television shows such as *Have I Got News for You, QI* and *Countdown* alongside his weekly podcast, *The Rabbit Hole Detectives* with Earl Spencer and Dr Cat Jarman.

Reverend Coles was a contestant on the BBC's Strictly Come Dancing in 2017. Since 2014 he has appeared regularly in the Pause for Thought slot on the BBC Radio 2 Breakfast Show and in the summer of 2016 took part in the BBC's prime-time programme Celebrity Masterchef. Most recently he co-presented The Big Painting Challenge on BBC One. Reverend Coles was also one half of the 1980s popular music duo, The Communards, with whom he had three top ten hits.

In addition, he has a keen interest in social enterprise, particularly in the field of housing. He serves as a board member of Wellingborough Homes, which provides social and affordable housing in the area.

To date, Reverend Coles has published six books, two volumes of autobiography, *Fathomless Riches* and *Bringing in the Sheaves*, a personal account of life after grief, *The Madness of Grief*, two volumes of the lives of lesser-known saints, *Lives of the Improbable Saints* and *Legends of the Improbable Saints* and a novel, *Murder before Evensong*.

Reverend Coles received an honorary doctorate from the University in 2012.

# **Anne-Marie Kilday The Vice Chancellor.**



Professor Anne-Marie Kilday is Vice Chancellor and Professor of Criminal History at the University of Northampton.

She writes and researches on various aspects of criminal history, particularly focusing on violent behaviour and gendered criminality.

Professor Kilday started her academic career in Scotland working at the University of Strathclyde and then the University of Glasgow. She joined Oxford Brookes University in 2000 as a Lecturer in Early Modern History and progressed her career at the University securing various promotions from Principal Lecturer through to Dean. She was promoted into the senior leadership team becoming the Pro Vice-Chancellor for Research and Knowledge Transfer and Impact in 2012 and then became Pro Vice-Chancellor Student Experience & University Community, with institutional responsibility for all aspects of both student and staff experience in 2018 and continued in that role until she left for the University.

Anne-Marie enjoys supporting Oxford United and Celtic football clubs, playing table tennis, reading true crime and crime fiction, and chasing after her three cats Duncan, Angus and Rori.



### David Laing Pro Chancellor.

David was born into the Laing construction family. He qualified as an architect and subsequently worked with Sir Basil Spence's London firm before setting up a private practice in Hertfordshire, as well as becoming a partner in GHM Rock Townsend.

With his knowledge of the construction industry, David became chairman of Country and Metropolitan and has been a director of Eskmuir, a quoted property company which was taken private and is the Laing family's property vehicle. As well as being a director of a number of private companies, he has served as a trustee, Chairman, or President, of many charities including the Northamptonshire Community Foundation, the Northamptonshire Association of Youth Clubs and Adrenaline Alley, the biggest urban sports park in the UK. David was Lord Lieutenant of Northamptonshire from 2014 to 2020.

He has had experience in the leisure sector, as well as agriculture, being hands-on at his farm at Brigstock, Northamptonshire. He has been living in the county for over ten years and is committed to making it known as the Heart of England.



# Sue Dutton Deputy Chair, Board of Governors.

Sue Dutton has extensive teaching and managerial experience in education. She began her professional career teaching English in secondary schools and held a number of senior posts before moving into higher education.

At the Open University she was appointed to senior administrative roles in Student Services and the Vice-Chancellor's Office before becoming Director of Strategy, Planning and Resources in the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. She now works as a counsellor and psychotherapist.

Her academic research interests focus on the factors that attract and retain young students at the Open University.

# The History of the University of Northampton.

Between 1261 and 1265, Northampton was sanctioned by Henry III as an alternative place of study for hundreds of students displaced from Oxford and Cambridge universities during a period of civil unrest. Had it not been for a mischievous complaint to the King that the creation of a rival university would dilute the quality of education at Oxford, Northampton might have been England's third university.

The contemporary University of Northampton's roots lies firmly in the late 19th century, when new educational initiatives in science, technology and art education were developed to help support the needs of the region's industries. Science and technology found their first formal home in the old Northampton Grammar School premises at Abington Square in 1911, while art settled in nearby premises in Abington Street.

By 1924 plans were underway for a purpose-built College of Technology on St George's Avenue Campus, which formally opened in 1932. The College of Art opened a purpose-built wing at the same site in 1937. At the time it was hoped this would be a basis for the beginnings of a university in Northampton, realising a long unfulfilled hope of restoring the fledgling 13th century university.

Although the St George's Avenue Campus had to wait 70 years to see university status realised, the intervening decades provided strong foundations for today's University. This included the provision of part-time study towards degree qualifications under the auspices of first Cambridge, and then Leicester University.

However, by the early 1970s Northamptonshire found itself one of only three counties in England that didn't have a teacher training college. Although in a strong position to achieve this, it was felt that a stronger case could be made by amalgamation with an already established college. The opportunity which presented itself was a Liverpool college that had been made homeless after the Ministry of Defence reclaimed the site on which it had been established.

The Liverpool partner was Kirkby Fields College of Education. Effectively relocated 120 miles, and combined with the emerging







Northampton College, the joint venture found a home at Moulton Park in 1972.

To offset lean years in national teacher training provision, the Education College had to diversify, and the first stage was amalgamation with the Technical and Arts Colleges on St George's Avenue, Northampton, to form Nene College in 1975. In 1978 the National Leathersellers' Centre relocated to Northampton, and in 1981 the Blackwood Hodge (later Sunley) Management Centre opened.

The name chosen for the college was significant. The River Nene flowed through both town and county and was a link with the world beyond. It provided a strong sense of unification, which has continued in the University crest. Even after the Privy Council agreed the new institutional title of University College Northampton in February 1999, this unifying concept continued, binding the rising University to the enterprise and endeavour of Northampton and Northamptonshire.

In the early 1990s Nene acquired the last of its core subject areas: Health. As far back as 1981 it had acquired some health education from Milton Keynes College, and the School of Podiatry in 1989. In 1993 the college added St Andrew's School of Occupational Therapy, and in 1994, the Sir Gordon Roberts College of Nursing and Midwifery.

In August 2005 University College Northampton confirmed that it was to be awarded formal university status and full research degree awarding powers, becoming the University of Northampton. This development followed years of extensive work by staff across all levels at the University.

Today the University of Northampton looks forward to a bright future. In September 2018, the University welcomed the first cohort of students at the new, purpose-built Waterside Campus, having combined the learning, teaching and research facilities from the former two campuses to a new location in Northampton town centre, as part of the Northampton Waterside Enterprise Zone. As the county's only dedicated provider of higher education, the institution continues to build on its already well-established legacy by offering a complete educational, consultancy and research provision – from foundation and undergraduate level, through to postgraduate and doctoral qualifications.







# Celebration of University Professors.

The title of Professor recognises an individual's high levels of achievements and standing in their particular area or discipline. Professors have to demonstrate a major contribution to knowledge through either research or consultancy, to teaching, learning and development, or to professional achievement and practice.

At these ceremonies, we are celebrating some of the newest Professors representing a diverse range of disciplines, from education to leather science and business.

These appointments demonstrate the University's growing excellence in research, enterprise and professional practice and are key in supporting the University's ambitions for research and knowledge exchange. The University, our students and communities locally, nationally and further afield benefit from the expertise and commitment these individuals have demonstrated.

### Thursday 4 May at 10am Professor of International Business, Shaowei He

Professor Shaowei joined the University of Northampton in 2008 after obtaining his PhD in Economic Development from the University of Birmingham.

His research interests cut across the boundaries of international business, economic geography and innovation studies, with his work being published in leading academic journals and presented at international conferences. Shaowei has been successful in securing funding from Leverhulme/British Academy and British Council to pursue research on the impact of internationalisation on Chinese firms and associated issues such as power relationships, communication and culture.

Shaowei is the Faculty of Business and Law Research and Enterprise Lead and has previously led the University of Northampton China and Emerging Economies research centre, contributing his expertise and experience in developing the Faculty's research culture. Shaowei has led the Research Centre in helping British and Chinese institutions to identify and materialise collaboration opportunities. He is a Visiting Professor of Guangdong University of Finance and Economics and Jianghan University, both in China. He is a Senior Editor for the International Journal of Emerging Markets and has recently been appointed as Ambassador for International Exchange by the Hunan Provincial Government of China.

#### Friday 5 May at 1pm Professor of Leather Science, Will Wise

Professor Will Wise has a background in chemistry, his PhD was in the area of bio-organic chemistry and he was then a postdoctoral researcher in the field of materials chemistry.

He joint the Institute for Creative Leather Technologies (ICLT) as a Senior Lecturer in 2014 and became the Research Leader for ICLT in 2019 - driving the research programme for the whole subject. Then in 2022 he was promoted to professor.

Will has lead on a number of projects including research into chromium (VI) detection in leather, three knowledge transfer partnerships looking into alternative tannages (derived from industrial waste) and alternatives to water. He is also co-author on Tanning Chemistry; the science of leather (edition 2) which is the seminal treatise for Leather Science.

Alongside his research duties Will teaches on Leather Science modules and is the programme leader for the level 7 (MSc level) and level 8 (PhD level) qualifications. Will is currently Vice President of the Society of Leather Technologists & Chemists.

#### Friday 5 May at 1pm Professor of Child Advocacy Eunice Lumsden

Professor Lumsden has spent over 40 years working with, and advocating for, children, young people and families. Her current work in Higher Education including her research and advisory roles is underpinned by her experiences as a social worker.

She spent 22 years working alongside children and adults of all ages and in different contexts. This taught her about how our earliest experiences can impact across our lifetime. Driven by these experiences, she entered Higher Education determined to ensure that the 'voices' of those she had worked with informed policy makers and the education of students.

Her work on child protection and workforce development has received national and international recognition and she has been appointed to several Government advisory groups. The most recent being to the Early Years Healthy Development Review conducted by the Department of Health and Social Care. She has also been a member of expert groups advising the Department for Education on Early Years qualifications and was appointed by the Institute of Apprenticeships and Technical Education to the Route Panel for Education and Early Years, advising on technical qualifications. She led on the development of the Early Childhood Graduate Competencies, now embedded in universities across the UK.

Professor Lumsden has received several awards including a Teaching Fellowship for her work transitioning students into Higher Education. She has also received awards for her 'Changemaking' work and research in the early years and infant mental health. In 2021 she was chosen as a 'Women of the Year' in the prestigious Women of the Year Lunch for her advocacy work for children. In the same year she was also awarded the Picasso Jaspar Award for Inclusion and Diversity, awarded by the GEM network at the University of Northampton.

# Friday 5 May at 1pm Professor of Education, Jane Murray

As Professor of Education, Jane Murray PhD researches, teaches, supervises, advises and has published widely on many diverse aspects of education, with specialisms in early childhood education, social inclusion and participatory research.

When she was a child, Jane attended numerous different types of school because her father's career in banking meant the family moved regularly. These diverse experiences sparked a lifelong fascination with education and Jane's first encounter with a Higher Education Institution was her initial teacher education at the College of St Paul and St Mary (now University of Gloucestershire) where she was awarded a Bachelor of Education degree. Jane then spent two decades working as a qualified teacher in early childhood settings and primary schools in Buckinghamshire and Northamptonshire. During this time, she completed her Master's degree in Education at what was University College Northampton, and later she was awarded the National Professional Qualification for Headship (NPQH).

Jane joined University College Northampton (UCN) as a Senior Lecturer in Education in 2003, working on a range of undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in the field of Education, including teacher education, and leading the BA (Hons.) Early Years Education programme and MA Education (Early Years) pathway. In 2005, UCN became University of Northampton and in 2013 awarded Jane's PhD for her thesis 'An Exploration of Young Children's Engagements in Research Behaviour', supervised by Professor Richard Rose and Professor Philip Gammage. In the same year, Jane was appointed a researcher at the Centre for Education and Research, where she has co-led with Dr Cristina Devecchi since 2017. She also sits on several local Trust Boards, including Preston Hedges Trust and NN Contemporary Arts. Jane holds the Senior Fellowship of the Higher Education Academy (SFHEA); to date she has examined more than twenty doctoral studies and has been supervisor to over thirty PhD candidates.

Having worked with government education departments and ministries in countries including Ethiopia, Bhutan, Georgia and the UK, Jane has also worked in partnership with national and international organisations including UNICEF, the European Commission and The National Gallery in England. As Principal Investigator or Co-Investigator she has worked on a diverse collection of funded projects ranging from international research addressing children's social and emotional learning (UNICEF) and science outdoors for children aged 3-11 years (European Commission) to local studies about early literacy (Northamptonshire County Council), children starting school (Foundations for Children Nursery School Consortium) and children's outdoor play (Northampton Leisure Trust). For her work leading research in arts education, Jane was awarded the 2020 Anna Craft Creativities in Education Prize by the British Educational Research Association, Iane has published many peer-reviewed journal articles from her research addressing formal, informal and non-formal education. From the Young Children Are Researchers study, she authored Building Knowledge in Early Childhood Education: Young Children Are Researchers (Routledge, 2017). Her edited books include Early Childhood Pedagogies: Creating spaces for young children to flourish' (Routledge, 2019), and The Routledge International Handbook of Young Children's Rights (Routledge, 2019), featuring 70+ international authors. Jane is also influential globally in the production of new knowledge about early childhood education as Editorin-Chief for the peer-reviewed International Journal of Early Years Education (2016-) published by Taylor & Francis.

Jane lives in Northamptonshire. She has been married to Stephen for 38 years, and they have three children: Jemima and Fergus work in education and Will is an RAF pilot.

#### **Coat of Arms**



The themes associated with the Coat of arms are essentially concerned with the physical location of the University within the Borough of Northampton and the County of Northamptonshire, together with the central activities of the University.

The Borough is depicted in the left-hand supporter, a lion rampant, and in the central triple-turreted castle. It is also evident in the similar castle footstools for both supporters. The Main County reference is in the right-hand supporter of a bull with a golden chain and is depicted in the Tudor rose held by the roebuck. The County colours of blue, green and silver are also a feature of the Coat of Arms.

The linking of Borough and County through the imagery of the River Nene is strongly pursued with two horizontal representations of the river, one on the central shield and one below the supporters.

The University's activities are reflected in the central feature of books of learning and the vocational technology perspective is illustrated by linked cogwheels. The University's concern with learning is nicely encapsulated in the motto `Ne Nesciamus' - Let us not be ignorant'. The first four letters spelling Nene, for Nene College, an antecedent institution title of the University of Northampton.
