M02/23 Minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the previous meeting held on 9 November 2022 were confirmed as a true and accurate record.

M03/23 Matters arising (not elsewhere on the agenda)

The Chair confirmed that 2 actions remained outstanding to be referred to the next meeting.

- i) Updating of Financial Guidance on website (M50/22).

M04/23 Chair's actions

- i) The Chair passed on comments from the Vice Chancellor that there is some duplication between the Staff EDI Forum and the Student EDI Forum which needs to be addressed by both Chairs, ideally before the next meeting on 29 March 2023. Staff who attend both meetings agreed with the duplication of a number of areas and suggested that where there are differences, these could be tackled by sub-groups.

- ii) Preparations for the 2023 TEF are currently being finalised and the Chair would like to identify now what is required to prepare for the 2028 TEF so the University can identify how to get there at an early stage and modify if necessary.

M05/23 Technology supporting Equality, Diversity and Inclusion

- The new Students Record Systems – SITS - will be able to use students' choice of preferred name, choice of pronouns and correct pronunciation.
- NILE can already do so and cope with changes.
- The Ally tool allows students to choose the text format they use e.g. tagged PDFs, HTML and e-pub.
- Microsoft Immersive provides guidance for staff producing documents requiring increased accessibility. All documents can be scored for accessibility.
- Administrator tools such as Kaltura video captions can be used to provide awards.
- Other systems such as Tribal will also include these features.
- A question was posed regarding how this information will be communicated to students? This will be done via the Students' Union and it was suggested that these tools could be included in staff induction and an enhanced Welcome Week for students

M06/23 To receive papers on equality, diversity and progression from Emily Fletcher, BIMi Officer

Emily highlighted the following points:

- i) [Progression 21-22](#)
- Progression at Level 5 was the biggest change following the pandemic having reduced from 76.1% to 66.5% in 2021-2022;
 - Level 4 progression at 68.9% was slightly lower than academic year 2020-2021
 - The GEM progression rate has decreased;
 - GEM withdrawal rates have increased and is now higher for female students than male students.
- ii) [Undergraduate good degrees 21-22](#)
- Data came from HESA data and can be viewed on Qlikview;
 - There was a reduction in good degrees from 29.4 x 1st class degrees to 25.9% in a single year;

- There was a corresponding increase in lower second class degrees and 3rd class honours degrees;
- The gap between white students and GEM students has increased from 16.1% to 27.5% in 2021 – 2022;
- It was agreed that concern about GEM data requires assessment of the cause as ethnicity appears to be a key feature of intersections with data;
- Is changed data a trend or a blip and is intervention by the University required?
- Withdrawals data will be available by programme on Qlikview shortly;
- Around March 2023, sector-wide data will be available;
- It was commented that results in 2021-2022 may be due to the withdrawal of the academic regulations in force during the pandemic;
- It would be useful to have information on all students' achievement on entry and final achievement

M07/23 To note progress of the APP conditions and priorities from the Head of Access and Participation Tim Dobson

Tim updated APP developments by explaining that that his team were looking first at interventionality and will examine commitments made to decide whether these should be retained, released or modified in the light of findings or changes to OfS requirements.

- The Equality of Risk Register is awaited.
- Raising awareness of the APP is taking place across Higher Education Institutions (HEIs).

M08/23 Update from Students

- The President updated the meeting on progress appointing Black Student Advocates. There are now 9 in post who meet weekly as a team.
- Student Networks are now operational and include LGBTQ+ students, BME students and Women students.
- In response to a question, it was established that currently there are Networks at Levels 5 and 6 but none at Level 4 as yet.
- There are currently 7 staff supporting Student Networks in post 8 hours per week.
